

First and foremost, a useful suggestion for solving the problem would be to join a volunteering programme which supports individuals that have been displaced both emotionally and economically. Furthermore, as far as countries accepting refugees are concerned, their governments should not put the blame for economic and social problems on the displaced but they need to deal with xenophobia and discrimination instead. As a result, this would enable them to apply for asylum or resettle in case they are extremely vulnerable and also to be offered basics such as education and healthcare. Moreover, it is crucial that world leaders prioritise saving lives by investing in search and rescue operations for people being in distress.

All things considered, refugee crisis constitutes one of the most serious problems these days. This is the reason why it is advisable that countries welcoming refugees should strain every power to allow them to lead a normal and productive life. After all, we are all humans and we all deserve to claim our right to dignity!
